Course Title: Chinese 4 AP IB

Course Prerequisites: Refer to Registration Presentation

Course Description:

Chinese 4 APIB prepares the students to successfully take the Chinese AP and/or IB exams. This course prepares students to demonstrate their level of Chinese proficiency by applying interpersonal, interpretive, and presentational skills in real-life situations. Students will also develop necessary knowledge of the Chinese language, including pronunciation, vocabulary, idiomatic expressions, grammatical structures, and written/typed characters

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:

Concepts: Students should demonstrate awareness and appreciation of the Chinese cultural products, practices, and perspectives to be successful in the intense drilling in listening and speaking.

Skills: Students should possess proficient vocabulary skills, communication, strategies, language control and cultural awareness to succeed in intensive reading and writing practice.

Workload Expectations for this course:

- Students are expected to have:
- Daily in –class reading, writing, listening and speaking
- Weekly writing, reading, homework and tests
- Daily practice of AP and IB Exams
- Daily practice of rich vocabulary, idiomatic expressions, and grammatical structures
