Course Title: French 1

Course Prerequisites: Refer to Registration Presentation

Course Description:

French 1 will cover basics of speaking, writing, reading, and listening in the French language to a novice – beginner intermediate level per Stage 1 of the CA State Standards for World Languages. The course will focus on emerging interpretive, interpersonal and presentational communication in the present tense. Students will also French culture pertaining to geography, arts, gastronomy (food), and practices/products of the French – speaking world.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:

- Bring your passion for language learning or the French culture
- Prepare to become a global citizen of the world

Workload Expectations for this course (list typical amount of homework, projects, presentations, papers, etc.):

- Homework will be assigned regularly (as needed; typically 10-15 minutes per night)
- Projects – twice per semester (at least)
- Papers – mostly short text and small amounts of paragraph writing
- Use of Chromebooks and Technology
- Students need to be prepared to speak in French
