Course Title: French 2

Course Prerequisites: Refer to Registration Presentation

Course Description:

French 2 will continue practice of speaking, writing, reading, and listening in the French language to an intermediate level per Stage 2 of the CA State Standards for World Languages. The course will continue to focus on interpretive, interpersonal and presentational communication; including the past and future tenses. Students will also study French culture pertaining to the French châteaux, French artists, gastronomy (food), and a more in-depth look at the practices/products of the French-speaking world.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:

- A passing C or above grade in French 1
- Proficiency at the novice level in speaking/reading/writing in French

Workload Expectations for this course (list typical amount of homework, projects, presentations, papers, etc.):

- Homework will be assigned regularly (as needed; typically 10-15 minutes per night)
- Projects – twice per semester (at least)
- Papers – mostly short text and small amounts of paragraph writing
- Use of Chromebooks and Technology
- Students need to be prepared to speak in French in a French – immersion setting
