Course Title: French 3

Course Prerequisites: Refer to Registration Presentation

Course Description:

This course will afford students a comprehensive presentation of culture, history and grammar of French and Francophone countries using the communicative, interpersonal and presentational modes as an interdisciplinary experience. Classes will be held in the target language, except where clarification is necessary. The students will read the original version of Le Petit Prince by St. Exupery and numerous other short stories by Eugene Ionesco, Rene Goscinny, and DeMaupassant. Culture will be stressed through virtual tours, we quests, readings, studies of countries and Internet research. The study of idioms and a broadening of vocabulary will increase the student's competency in the language. All major grammatical structures and tenses will be learned during this year of language study.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills: ACTFL Guidelines – Inermediate Low or above.

It is absolutely essential that the student be present and prepared in order to be successful in this class.
