REHEARSAL for Commencement:

Wednesday, May 29th, 10:30am at Fullerton High School Stadium. Please be on time, rehearsal will start promptly at 10:30am. Allow extra time for parking. PARKING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED AT FULLERTON HIGH SCHOOL. It is recommended that you get dropped off or carpool to limit parking needs. You may park in the parking structure off Lemon and Chapman. **Please note that parking structures require a permit to be purchased.**

Seniors must attend the graduation rehearsal to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Students who abstain from participating in the graduation ceremony may pick up their diplomas in the school office on or after June 5th.

SENIOR NIGHT: Thursday, May 23rd 3:00-4:30 pm in the TRHS North Gym.

This is a time for seniors to get their cap and gowns, and have their yearbook signed.

CAPS & GOWNS:

If you have not ordered your cap and gown, please submit your order at: www.jostens.com

All caps and gowns will be issued to seniors in the North Gym @ Senior Night, May 23rd from 3:00-4:30pm. THIS WILL BE THE ONLY DISTRIBUTION DAY FOR CAPS & GOWNS. Any senior who has not pre-paid will need to pay **\$50.00 CASH** on the day of distribution and be fitted at that time. (Caps and gowns will only be distributed for seniors who have no fines, fees or holds).

GRADUATION TICKETS:

All students will receive **7** *tickets* at the graduation practice. Family and friends, including children, must have a ticket to attend the Graduation Ceremony. The front office does not hold extra tickets. Extra tickets can only be acquired from other students or families who are not using all of their issued tickets.

REFLECTIONS & SENIOR AWARDS: Wednesday, May 29 - 6:30pm in the TRHS North Gym

This celebration is designed for the seniors to reflect on their four years at Troy. Seniors will wear their cap and gown and any other stoles and cords they have earned. PSS Imaging will provide a formal picture opportunity before Reflections at 5:00pm, as well as after the ceremony. Each senior will receive a free 5x7. Parents can purchase additional photos.

GRADUATION CEREMONY: Thursday, May 30

Seniors must report to the Fullerton HIgh School Tennis courts by 5:45 p.m. on Thursdav May 30th.. Please remember participation in the commencement exercises is VOLUNTARY. Participation will require acceptable and considerate conduct by every senior.

- It is expected that all seniors dress appropriately in comfortable, semi-formal attire that reflects the importance of the commencement ceremony.
- There will be no high heels or stilettos allowed on the stadium turf, only platform heels.
- Students are ALLOWED to carry car keys into the ceremony.
- Students are NOT allowed to bring cell phones or other personal belongings into the ceremony.
- Graduates will NOT be allowed to decorate their caps or wear anything extra with their caps and gowns.

Only approved stoles may be worn.

DIPLOMAS:

Diplomas will be issued to graduates on Friday, May 31 st in the morning upon return from Grad Nite. Students who do not attend Grad Nite will be able to pick them up on **Tuesday**, **June 4th between 9:00am and 12:00 pm and any day thereafter.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

FINES

All fines and holds (Library, Textbook, P.E., Counseling, Returned Checks, etc.) must be cleared PRIOR to picking up cap & gown or diploma. Fines must be paid by cash, credit card, cashier's check, or money order. Please pay by May 10th. NO PERSONAL CHECKS ACCEPTED after May 10th. Check the posted list of fines outside the Activities Office.

TEXTBOOKS:

A final list of unreturned second semester books will be printed and taken to graduation practice. Any senior who does not return all textbooks by Tuesday, May 28th will not receive their diploma until either the books are returned or the fine is paid.

ELIGIBILITY FOR COMMENCEMENT:

In order to participate in Reflections or the Commencement ceremony, all students must be eligible for graduation by the rehearsal time and date. Graduates must have completed <u>all</u> District requirements. Parents and seniors in doubt about their status should contact the Counseling office for clarification.

SENIOR BREAKFAST:

This is a fun event; seniors do not want to miss it! A special senior breakfast will be held Tuesdav. May 28th. @ 8:30 am at Splitsville at Downtown Disney. Following the breakfast, those who purchased Disneyland tickets have the option to attend Disneyland for the day as a class. If you have a season pass you do not need to purchase a ticket. Senior breakfast is \$25 w/ ASB and \$30 w/o ASB paid at the activities office.
