Any student enrolled in AP courses have the option to take the AP exam for that course in May 2021. The cost will be approximately \$99.00 per exam (includes registration fee). Late registrations will have an additional fee. If a student is enrolled in the Free & Reduced Lunch Program (FRLP), they are eligible for AP exam waivers.
