### **Booster Clubs FAQs**

### **Booster Club Insurance**

- We recommend <u>RVNuccio</u> (based on the cost and coverage provided). The cost is \$155 for the entire school year, and this covers you for all your events as long as they are not on the "no coverage list". Must renew by July 1, of each new school year. Please use the District address, not the school site address.
- Another third-party vendor for insurance coverage is <u>eventhelper.com</u>. Same as above please use the District address, not the school site address.
- You can also purchase insurance from an insurance broker/company of your choice.

# Athletic Stipends

As of this year, there is no limit on the number of stipends supported by Booster Clubs, however, we must follow the stipend guideline in the CBA and no more than one stipend per coach during the school year.

Stipends are calculated at the rate of "Any other Assistant Coach". The maximum Take Home amount allowed is \$3,746.43. This information has been updated on slide #31 in the 2024/25 Booster Compliance Presentation. The presentation can be found on the district website.

Summer Athletic Stipends cannot exceed the Summer Teaching Hourly rate of \$50.59 (for 2024-25), with a maximum of 6 weeks / 4 days per week / 5.25 hours per day for a Total *Take Home* amount of \$5,843.15 *This information has been updated on slide #35 in the 2024/25 Booster Compliance Presentation. These additional stipends are NOT mandatory. They are based on what the Booster Club can raise and what you decide to pay your coach(es).

If the booster club wants to cover the "employer taxes" below are the percentages:

The District will publish updated Benefits percentage rates in the spring, which will be applicable for the summer of 2025.

## **Fundraisers**

 Student participation is strictly on a voluntary basis in any allowable fundraising activities.

### Sidewalk activities

 This is on the Disallowed Activities list for liability reasons, please check with your insurance for coverage before engaging in any Sidewalk fundraising activities, which is not on District property.

### Youth Car wash

- This type of activity is NOT allowed on District property.
- For Car washed off district property, this is on the Disallowed activities list for liability reasons, please check with your insurance for coverage before engaging in any Sidewalk fundraising activities, which is not on District property.
- Student participation is strictly on a voluntary basis
- Professional sport ticket sales for games
  - Allowable fundraising might include selling professional sports tickets for fundraising revenues.
  - District students cannot participate in Professional Athletic events for compensation.
  - District facilities cannot be used for Professional Athletic events of any kind, which involve professional athletes.

## **Concessions**

- Food handlers permits are required to sell hot foods.
- Any food sales fundraising events on district facilities require coordination with the District Food Services Department to approve the food items being offered and provide guidance on required permitting.

# **Facilitron**

- All booster clubs must submit for approval for use of facilities in Facilitron.
- The site, AD, or coach CANNOT submit a request on your behalf.
  - This rule is in place to ensure that Booster clubs are submitting the required COI when booking district facilities.
- As Connected organizations, The booster club may have the Facility fees waived when the reservation is being finalized. However direct costs such as custodial costs, restroom fees, field or pool lighting fees, and staff overtime for after-hour events may still be applicable depending on the services requested.
