


Here is some important information for all Troy students from our Troy Counselors. Keep in mind that we are mid-year, so there should be few changes that would result in changing any year long courses. However, should there be a need for a student to make a significant schedule change, and if class space is available to allow a change, there is a timeline that must be followed. **Spring Semester Deadline to Drop an Additional Class or Class Level**

Students may request to drop an additional class or drop down in course levels (i.e., H/AP/IB to the lower level), if space is available. Students in grades 9-11 must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 classes; students in grade 12 must be enrolled in a minimum of 5 classes. <u>The</u> <u>deadline to drop an additional class or level down is Friday, March 17, 2023 by 3:30 p.m.</u> <u>Students</u> must see their school counselor <u>*in person*</u> before first period, at break, lunch, or after sixth period by the deadline.



Warriors! Or current 8th graders who are thinking about becoming Warriors next Fall, our Open House is next Wednesday night and begins at 6:00pm! Before Open House officially begins, at 5:00pm for current 8th graders who are interested in being incoming 9th graders, there is an Information Night (session) in the North Gym. Open House is always a great night, we are glad to be able to bring this event back this year after a couple missed years due to COVID. Do not miss this evening! 

- Application is NOW available: Applicants are encouraged to register online between today, and January 25, 2023 at <u>applicants.troyhigh.com</u>; however, applications are available at testing and walk-ins are welcome.
- Testing for Troy Tech, International Baccalaureate, Cambridge, or Honors placement: January 14, 21, or 28, 2023 (select one) from 7:30-11:45 a.m. Check-in at 7:15 a.m.; January 14 check-in at Library and January 21/28 at North Gym. Bring student photo id or passport and printout of 8th grade schedule listing current math course. Testing covers midyear eighth grade content in math and English, and the format includes






WHERE TO APPLY

Applications can **ONLY** be obtained in person at the school of residence. Applications cannot be mailed or emailed and will not be made available in advance.



WHAT TO BRING

Parent/guardian(s) must provide proof of residency within the District at the time of application. A gas, water or electricity bill AND rental agreement/mortgage statement.

SCHOOL CHOICE You may apply for only 1 school. If more than 1 application is received for a student, both applications will be voided and student will attend the school of residence.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



I do not reside within the District, can I apply?

No, you must be a resident of the Fullerton Joint Union High School District. If you are interested in attending one of our high schools, you may apply for an Interdistrict Transfer release from your district of residence.



What is the school of residence for my address?

Will my student be guaranteed acceptance into school of choice?

No, acceptance is based on the number of spaces available at each school. Spaces are **NOT** based on a first-come-first-serve basis. A lottery system will be established if number of applications exceeds the number of spaces.



Is transportation provided?

No, transportation is not provided.




Does Open Enrollment need to be renewed annually?

No, it is valid for 4 years; HOWEVER a minimum attendance of 1 school year is required.
