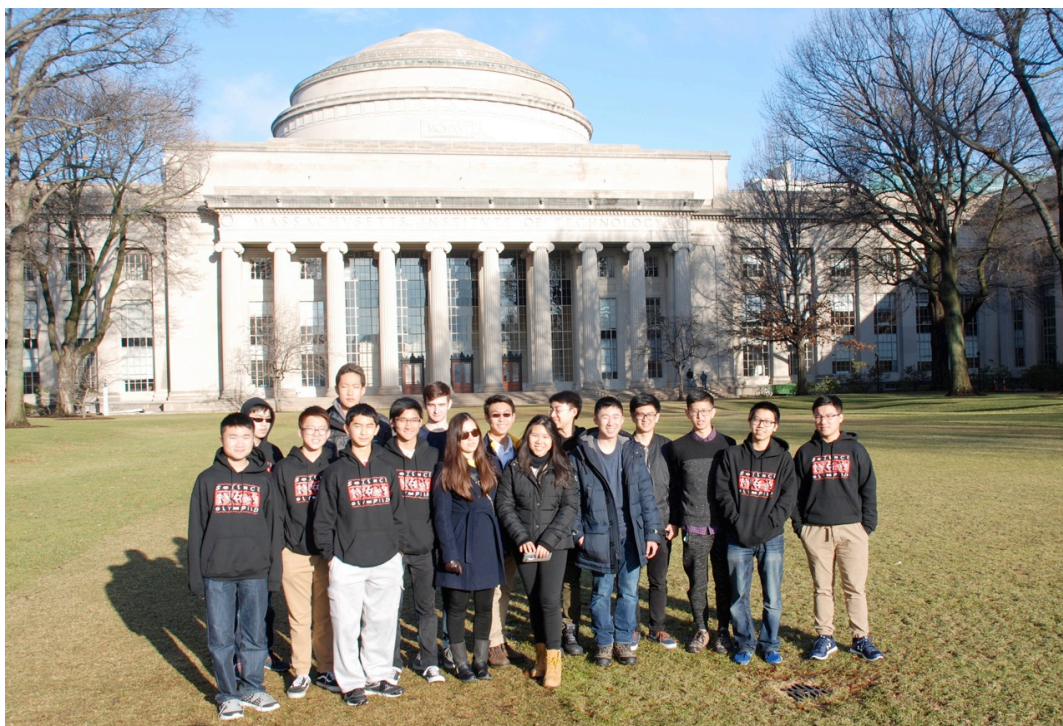

This is what the gym looked like last week. It will be far, far, busier tomorrow!



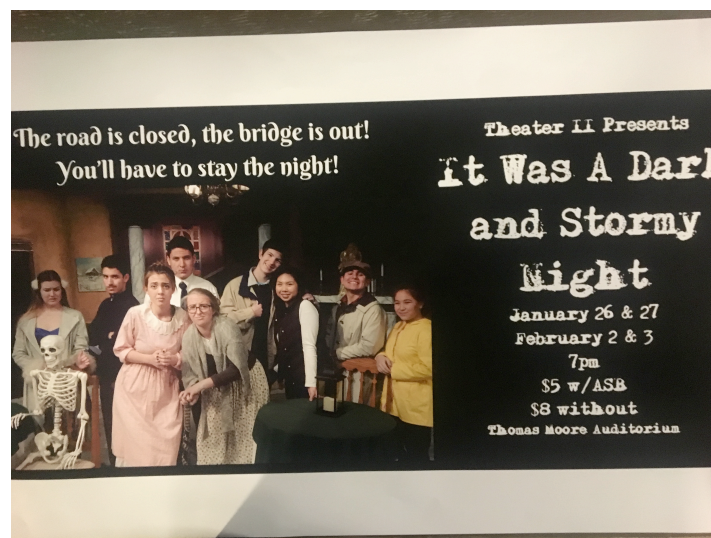
