



FJUHSD Students Outperform County and State!

Dear FJUHSD Staff Members, Students, Parents/Guardians, and Community,

The statewide assessment, known as the Smarter Balanced exam, taken in the spring of each school year, is part of the statewide accountability system known as the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress, or CAASPP. The academic assessment covers three subject areas - English Language Arts (ELA), mathematics, and science, and is administered for students in grades 3-8 and grade 11. As FJUHSD is grades 9-12, our results are for grade 11 only.

Assessment results for the 2022/23 administration of the exam were publicly released today by the California Department of Education.

FJUHSD students outperformed the **statewide average** in all three subject areas in grade 11:

12 percentage points higher in ELA 17 percentage points higher in math 10 percentage points higher in science

FJUHSD students outperformed the **countywide average** in all three subject areas in grade 11:


3 percentage points higher in ELA 6 percentage points higher in math 1 percentage point higher in science








I am also proud of Troy High School and Staff and Students. In this chart are growth numbers, and while it may be assumed and that Troy is important in overall percentages, a key part of these charts is the growth. This year, while Troy does well in ELA and Math, we were not the drivers in most of the growth sections. Where we are the driver districtwide is in the Science section where we contributed 5.07 percentage points of growth (Troy is 72.09%). This does not mean we are all the district growth in Science, but we had a larger role in Science than the others were we contributed .75 percentage points of growth in Math (Troy is 74.88%) and .67 percentage points of growth in ELA (Troy is 86.65%). Again, congratulations to the entire FJUSHD and for another great performance by Troy High School's students and teachers for continuing to elevate our academic achievement on the CAASPP! Great job!
