"Congratulations on your outstanding performance on the ACT test! You have earned the highest possible ACT composite score of 36. Your achievement on the ACT is significant and rare. About one-quarter of 1% of all test takers earn the top score. Among U.S. high school graduates in the class of 2022, just 3,376 out of more than 1.34 million students who took the ACT earned a composite score of 36. Your exceptional scores will provide college and universities with ample evidence of your readiness for the academic rigors that lie ahead. ACT scores are accepted by major four-year colleges and universities across the U.S. Test scores are one of multiple criteria that colleges consider when making admission decisions." Here is some exciting CyberPatriot news from our Cyber Coach Extraordinaire, Mr. David Kim! "I thought I'd share the preliminary results from Round 2 that came out just today from CyberPatriot. Although we don't know the exact number of Troy teams that made it to Platinum tier this year as of now, based on Round 2 scores alone, Troy's very own returning champions Runtime Terror is currently ranked 1st in the nation out of all 3557 teams, and Troy is also currently ranked 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in the NJROTC division. In addition, Troy has teams that are ranked 12th, 15th, and 21st in the Open division, which puts them at a good shot for qualifying for nationals. Once the finalized results come out (which will include how many Troy teams placed in Platinum tier), I will be sure to send everyone an update." I am so excited for our students and the opportunities available to them in the world of Cyber Defense. 

Troy Parents, here is some important information on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) from our Counselors and Administrative Teams!

Dear Troy High School Senior Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

We would like to provide you with information on state legislation, AB 469. The legislation requires all California seniors to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act (CADAA), and FJUHSD is required to confirm the submission of either application per California Ed Code Section 51225.7. This requirement expands financial aid opportunities for students who may not have the resources to attend a two-year community college or a four-year college or university. The next steps in this process are as follows:

If your student is a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, they complete the FAFSA

- The FAFSA opens in December 2023 and has a priority closing deadline of April 2, 2024.
- You and your child must create an FSA ID. Your FSA ID is a digital signature used to sign the

FAFSA application. Create your FSA ID now at:

If your student is undocumented, has or does not have DACA, has Temporary Protected Status or is a U Visa holder, they complete the CADAA

- The CADAA opens in December 2023 and has a priority closing deadline of April 2, 2024.


