Updated!!! CyberPatriot XVI Final Round 2 Results!

Here is the most updated CyberPatriot news from our Cyber Coach Extraordinaire, Mr. David Kim! "I hope you all had a great break! The following is a detailed version of the message from yesterday's morning announcements regarding updates from Rounds 1 and 2:

Last week, CyberPatriot released the finalized scores from Round 2. After Rounds 1 and 2, Troy placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in the NJROTC division out of 245 teams, and 1st, 14th, and 17th in the Open division out of 2113 teams. In addition, 88% of Troy teams placed in the Platinum tier this year (meaning they placed in the top 30% of their division in the nation), and more than half the Troy teams placed in the top 10% in the nation. Furthermore, all 12 Troy NJROTC teams placed in the Platinum tier this year as well. The next round, State Round, will be next Saturday, where the top 25% from each tier will move onto the Semifinal Round."



Troy Parents, here is some important information on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) from our Counselors and Administrative Teams!

Dear Troy High School Senior Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

We would like to provide you with information on state legislation, AB 469. The legislation requires all California seniors to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act (CADAA), and FJUHSD is required to confirm the submission of either application per California Ed Code Section 51225.7. This requirement expands financial aid opportunities for students who may not have the resources to attend a two-year community college or a four-year college or university. The next steps in this process are as follows:

If your student is a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, they complete the FAFSA

- The FAFSA opens in December 2023 and has a priority closing deadline of April 2, 2024.
- You and your child must create an FSA ID. Your FSA ID is a digital signature used to sign the

FAFSA application. Create your FSA ID now at:

If your student is undocumented, has or does not have DACA, has Temporary Protected Status or is a U Visa holder, they complete the CADAA

- The CADAA opens in December 2023 and has a priority closing deadline of April 2, 2024.

• The CADAA allows students to apply for state financial aid

The School Counseling Department will be hosting financial aid workshops to help senior students complete either application. Keep an eye on emails regarding these events. If you wish to opt out of completing either financial aid form, have your student see their school counselor during drop-in times for an opt-out form. Please note, opting out means your student will not receive potential federal or state student aid.






The Troy pool area at sunrise on November 30th.
