The 2nd AP exam administration is Digital at Home and began for our students on Tuesday, May 18th! For students taking the Digital at Home AP Exams, in the 2nd and 3rd AP testing administrations, please make sure you are following the College Board procedures for digital testing. This means students taking a digital exam must follow these procedures. From our AP Coordinator, Ms. Lisa Avila: “The digital, at-home AP exams will begin next week and it is imperative that students have followed the appropriate steps necessary to take the exam. If students are using school-issued Chromebooks, the app is already installed, but they still need to login and follow the additional instructions 1- 3 days before their exam and then logon 30 minutes before the start time on exam day. Students who are using their own at-home computer will need to download and install the digital app before logging in.
